NUMBER DISTRIBUTION

PRE-EVENT MEETING:

It will take place on Friday, May 2nd at 18:00 hrs at the entrance of the Mario Villanueva Madrid Stadium. Coaches or group representatives must attend.

SPORTS RISK

First aid services will be available. In case of hospitalization, expenses will be covered by the competitor or the club they represent, as the organization is not responsible for risks inherent to sports activities.

COMPETITION EQUIPMENT

PROTESTS:

They must be submitted in writing to the Appeals Jury within thirty minutes after the official announcement of the results. The protest must be signed by the coach and the athlete making the protest and must be accompanied by a deposit of \$150.00 MXN./ \$8 USD - The deposit will be refunded to the athlete if the claim is upheld.

JUDGES:

They will be appointed by the Organizing Committee, and electronic timing will be used.

MATTERS:

Any issues not foreseen in this call will be resolved during the preliminary meeting by the Organizing Committee.
